The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position based in Wau.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Frequent long trips to monitors the implementation of various Water and Habitat (WatHab) projects in Former Warrap, Northern & Western Bar Ghazel states
- Carry out activities related construction, monitoring and supervision of construction related activities
- Proposes and designs construction projects to meet the assessed needs, including monitoring and supervision of the projects
- Participates in the evaluation of projects: technical study, engineering drawings, bill of quantities and tender launching.
- Carry out water supply related activities, such as hand pump / borehole / water yard / water treatment plant rehabilitation, when required
- Manages teams of workers, provides technical expertise and ensures the project adheres to the pre-defined plan.
- Assists the delegate with assessments whenever necessary.
- Develops and maintains a network of relevant contacts relevant for water programs and engages authorities and beneficiaries in the projects.
- Assists the work in ICRC premises whenever required.

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- Bachelor Degree in civil engineering, some college coursework completed, an Associate Degree or equivalent higher education degree in construction, civil engineering or any related technical field.
- Additional vocational training in water supply, sanitation or any related technical field.
- 4-6 years of experience in construction, engineering or similar technical position.
- Advanced conversational in English and Arabic.
- Expert level in computer skills (including MSOffice and some CAD drawing and design software)
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning; Team Work, Planning, Organization & Assessment; Analysis & Synthesis; Responsibility & Autonomy.
- Familiarity with the standard norms and rules in construction, local techniques and requirements for construction.
- Driving license, succeeded in ICRC driving test.
- Experience in assessing, surveying, calculating and preparing estimates and technical drawings of buildings.
