JOB OPENING HEALTH FIELD OFFICER (WARD NURSE) Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position based in Juba.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Participates in setting up the local operating theatre and the area of postoperative care, in order to provide surgical care as early as possible,
- Provides adequate pre and post-operative care, in accordance with the ICRC standards,
- Assess the overall functioning of the pre and postoperative,
- Ensures the ICRC principles for post-operative nursing care of the war wounded and trauma cases are followed and adapted to the circumstances,
- Ensures that all items required for the ICRC pre and post-operative care are available in either in hospital assignment or in Flying Surgical Team deployment,
- Ensures that all items required for the nursing care are available and taken on deployment,
- Participates in the maintenance and the replenishment of the Flying Surgical Team kit (equipment, drugs and consumables) before and after an intervention,
- When deployed and in consultation with the other team members, ensures that the appropriate equipment/materials are available,
- Together with the OT nurse, monitors the ongoing needs for stock and utilizes impress system for reordering.
- Maintains admission records of patients as required.
- Provides ward statistics of the ward activities in close collaboration with the local counterparts as required and participate in providing information for monthly and quarterly reporting,
- Ensures correct ordering, donating and use of supplies and equipment,
- In the event of an emergency deployment of the mobile surgical team, prepare all necessary materials to allow for proper pre-and postoperative management of casualties in close collaboration with local counterparts,

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- Diploma or degree in Nursing or equivalent experience
- 3-5 years of experience in a humanitarian area, health
- Good level of English and Arabic, both written and spoken
- Good level in computer applications especially Word, Excel and Power-point
- Good knowledge of geographically assigned environment
- Willingness to learn and adapt.
