JOB OPENING WATER AND HABITAT TECHNICIAN Based in Bor

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent Organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Bor.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Frequent long trips to monitor the implementation of various water and Habitat (WatHab) projects in Jonglei state.
- Monitors the implementation of various WatHab projects around Jonglei. Manages the teams of workers, provides technical expertise and ensures the project adheres to the pre-defined plan.
- Carries out all possible activities related to hand-pump/ borehole/ water yard/ water treatment plant
- Assists in training and supporting the local pump mechanics on hand pump and generators repair.
- Supports the water user committees to ensure the maintenance and operation of any water point.
- Carries out all possible activities related to construction and rehabilitation of infrastructure in WatHab
- Provides support to Logistics department in identifying the correction materials and equipment under purchase to ensure smooth procurement.
- The employee is a specialist in a technical profession (plumber, electrician, carpenter, and mason).
- Assist the engineer in monitoring and the implementation of WatHab projects, ensuring they meet the required specification.

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- A' level or equivalent degree and technical skills or vocational training in construction, maintenance, logistics or any similar technical field. Some college coursework completed or an associated degree is
- 3-5 years' experience in construction, maintenance, logistics, mechanics or any similar technical field.
- Good command of English and Arabic. Knowledge of local languages is an advantage.
- Intermediate computer skills.
