OBJECTIVES OF THE POSITION:

Ensure smooth coordination of preventive and curative RH services in area of intervention and integrate them within the package offered in Leer/Adok.

ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES-

She/he in particular will:

- As part of the RH team, is responsible for the delivery of RH services in the fixed and mobile clinics as assigned.
- Participate in all mobile and statistic clinic activities which include but not limited to:
 - Promote the routine provision of ANC and PNC services at health facility level to ensure that pregnant women receive preventive care before and after delivery
 - Deliver routine immunization in the fixed and mobile clinics. Participate in vaccination campaigns.
 - Provide skilled attendance to birth and enhance BEmONC.

- Provide general nursing care in maternity ward and in the operation theater when needed.
- Ensure Proper and timely administration of prescribed drugs, infusion and any medical prescription to the patient.
- Ensure proper record of patient files
- .Ensure proper record of consumption of medical supplies.
- Ensure cleanliness of the ward
- Promote individual/couple FP to increase utilization rate.
- Facilitate the integration of HIV/AIDS counseling/testing/curative services
- Participate in community outreach sessions for ANC/PNC and EPI promotion.
- Participate in mass vaccination campaign
- Participate in mosquito nets distribution
- Participate in Training of Community Health Workers (CHWs)
- Assist health and nutrition staff in the establishment/strengthening of women group with the aim of raising community awareness on mother and child health.
- Actively Promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within International Medical Corps and amongst beneficiaries served by International Medical Corps
