SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

SAMARITAN'S PURSE IS LOOKING FOR A QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL(S) TO WORK AS A RELOCATABLE THEATRE NURSE. THE KEY RESPONSIBILITY OF THE THEATRE NURSE WILL BE MANAGEMENT OF PATIENTS IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER SURGERY.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Take comprehensive patient histories and perform physical examinations on patients
- Monitor patients well-being and progress, including but not limited to accurately taking and recording vital signs, fluid input and output and anthropometric measurements (weigh, height, MUAC)
- Safely administer drugs/medications including intravenous fluids & blood transfusions to patients as prescribed by clinicians
- Diligently perform nursing procedures, including but not limited to catheterization, NG tube insertion, vein-puncture, enema dressing changes, assist in patients feeding & collection of laboratory specimen.
- Assist Doctors in performing procedures including but not limited to abdominal parenthesis, incision & drainage, wound suturing and lumbar puncture.
- Upon training on the job work as a runner as well as a scrub nurse.
- Prepare for and actively participate in ward rounds
- Regularly conduct relevant health education /share health messages with patients and others seeking health services.
- Supervising and appraising theatre staff when required
- Be on call 24/7 for surgery and other emergency cases as need arise.
- Always document all relevant information pertaining to the care provided to the patients and share the same with other health care members involved
- Attend to patients spiritual/ emotional needs as appropriate
- Actively participate in continuing medical education sessions
- Attend and participate in staff meetings
- Take responsibility and account of equipment and supplies under your care
- Maintain a clean, tidy, safe and healthy work environment
- With a generous and serving spirit perform all other tasks & responsibilities assigned for the benefit of SP.
