**JOB OPENING
PHYSIOTHERAPIST**

Based in Juba with frequent travel to ICRC field sites

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Juba.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Registers and treats information with accuracy and with confidentiality;
- Sets dates for patient appointments for physiotherapy treatment with the coordination of the senior physiotherapist;
- Informs ICRC physiotherapist (or ICRC nurse in charge if ICRC physio is absent) of any problems that require follow up;
- Performs patient assessment and gives physiotherapy to the patients (identified during the round with their colleagues, setting daily the priorities);
- Assures that all patients receive appropriate physiotherapy according to their disabilities;
- Ensures that all patients receive appropriate information about stump care & the pre prosthesis period;
- Ensures that the patient will receive proper information about his further prosthesis/ orthosis if needed and will fill up a referral form to the PRRC;
- Performs appropriate patient assessment, updates the assessment when there are significant changes, and performs the final assessment reported in the patient physiotherapy file (in collaboration with all the Mobile Surgical Team (MST) participating to the round) before discharge;
- Participates to hospital rounds (with local staff & ICRC staff) as a full member of the MST;
- Participates in the weekly/ general cleaning of the wards as it is the responsibility of everyone to help decrease the risk of infections;
- Contributes in preparing statistics and other reports;
- Performs necessary paperwork and ensures follow up of the patients in the Out Patient Department;
- Forwards patient complaints immediately (in case of unusual requests or problems) without delay to the senior physiotherapist (or the ICRC Nurse in charge if ICRC physio absent).

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Diploma degree in Physiotherapy or equivalent experience;
- Preferably Registered Physiotherapist;
- 3-5 years' experience in Physical Rehabilitation Centre or Hospital work preferred;
- Written and spoken English, spoken Arabic;
- Intermediate computer knowledge;
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning, Team Work, Security Management, Planning, Organization & Assessment; Communication (Ability to express views and ideas).
