## JOB OPENING ECOSEC FIELD OFFICER Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position based in Juba.

### **Main Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Designs and contributes to the implementation (planning and execution), monitoring and follow-up and evaluation of relevant livelihood interventions;
- Explains project objectives and modalities in a comprehensive manner to potential beneficiaries as well as to other relevant interlocutors and provides them with constructive feedback;
- Identifies local technical support for the projects when needed;
- Ensures the work is executed according to the technical specifications and work schedules;
- Acts as the technical support for Cash for Work projects and provides technical support to beneficiaries when needed or upon request;
- Ensures appropriate internal technical reporting;
- Performs various data processing;
- Contributes to coaching of SSRC volunteers on project design, implementation and evaluation;
- Assists with setting up a simple, easy to follow market monitoring system for key sites as identified
- Participates in the establishment and implementation of procedures;
- Process paper work for staff movement such as Field Trip Form and help in field trip preparations; also ensure timely submission of all contributions to FTRs (Field Trip Reports) to the line manager.

### **Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:**

- 'A' Level (Higher/Advanced Higher Grade exam) or equivalent. Some college coursework completed in livelihood related domain or an Associate Degree
- Additional vocational training in a livelihood and/or socio-economic development field is an asset
- 3 years' work experience in related field (Community projects, CFW projects, Voucher projects in emergency or crises context)
- Very good command of written and spoken English, very good report writing and analytical skills and good computer skills particularly in Excel
- Experience in conducting livelihood projects
