JOB OPENING Nutrition Field Officer Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position based in Juba.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Identify needs and geographical areas in collaboration with the Sub-Delegation, and implement EcoSec activities in the field with the EcoSec Delegate;
- Conduct suitable baseline nutrition assessments/ surveys for the most 'at risk' livelihoods and/ or groups and determine priority areas for monitoring the nutritional situation;
- Facilitate preparation and delivery of nutrition and EcoSec trainings in close collaboration with the South-Sudan Red-Cross (SSRC); Contribute to EcoSec baseline development and keep these up-dated;
- Closely work and collaborate with Agro, Livestock and relief colleagues with regular follow up on FS situation, concerns and EcoSec responses that feed into nutrition with an aim to increase nutrition sensitive programming in food aid, agro and livestock responses;
- Close collaboration and training of the SSRC, relevant local authorities and actors on appropriate use of nutrition commodities as part of the beneficiary accountability strategy during distribution of nutritional supplements in line with ICRC South Sudan standard food basket;
- Quarterly evaluation of stock balances of nutrition stocks and contingency plans for distributions;
- Design and contribute to the implementation of relevant emergency interventions; Participate in establishment and implementation of procedures;
- Ensure appropriate internal technical reporting;
- Training of health staff/ SSRC volunteers on the treatment and management of acute malnutrition in health facilities, as well as nutritional management of other vulnerable population groups;
- Strong collaboration and working relations with nutrition implementing partners in area of responsibility, by establishing strengthened referral system mechanisms so as to strengthen CMAM and IYCF nutrition activities in the community;
- Attend relevant external coordination meetings as advised by EcoSec Nutrition Delegate at Juba level and Nutrition sector meetings in the respective program location;
- Perform various data processing on computer independently mainly FSS (Field Supply Systems)/ logistical documentation), EcoSec Program Management Tool (EPMT), and other statistics (that would require ICRC training).

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- University degree in Nutrition, food security, public health or in relevant field or equivalent higher education qualification;
- 3 years' work experience in related field (Nutrition assessments/ surveys and/ or feeding centre in emergency or crises context);
- Very good command of written and spoken **English**, very good report writing and analytical skills and very good computer skills particularly in Excel, very good organizational skills;
- Experience in conducting nutrition assessments/ surveys, CMAM & IYCF programming and relief activities.
