Organizational Background

International Medical Corps is a global, humanitarian, nonprofit organization dedicated to saving lives and relieving suffering through health care training and relief and development programs. Established in 1984 by volunteer doctors and nurses, International Medical Corps is a private, voluntary, nonpolitical, nonsectarian organization. Its mission is to improve the quality of life through health interventions and related activities that build local capacity in underserved communities worldwide. By offering training and health care to local populations and medical assistance to people at highest risk, and with the flexibility to respond rapidly to emergency situations, International Medical Corps rehabilitates devastated health care systems and helps bring them back to self-reliance.

Essential Job duties / Scope of Work:

- Conduct/participate in a Psychosocial needs assessment among the affected populations. This will include baseline assessments consistent with IASC guidelines and MHPSS WHO assessment toolkit (e.g. rapid community based assessment of psychosocial needs).
- Strengthen the capacity of communities in offering psychosocial support
- Strengthen mental health and psychosocial support for local health workers.
- Perform other duties as required by supervisors.
- Join or initiate emergency interagency coordination mechanisms for the provision of mental health and psychosocial support (IASC Reference group in coordination with IMC Mental Health and Psychosocial Advisor)
- Collaborate with existing government structures and local authorities organizing emergency response
- Identify suitable local partner organizations and institutions for joint MHPSS work

- Develop the strategy and mechanisms to integrate a psychosocial component into IMC programs in keeping with IASC guidelines of mental health and psychosocial support in emergencies
- Identify and where appropriate collaborate with existing indigenous healing services
- Facilitate emergency psychosocial support as needed to affected population (precise programming depending on identified needs, existing services and capacities and actions of other agencies)
- Actively Promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within International Medical Corps and amongst beneficiaries served by International Medical Corps

Qualifications:

- Postgraduate university degree in psychology/psychiatry/public health/behavioral science/ social science/medicine/nursing.
- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work within different cultural environments
- Ability to work within a team structure or in isolation, flexible, and can cope with stressful workloads and working with limited resources
- Ability to travel on short notice to project sites by car.
- A good command of verbal and written English. Knowledge of Nuer/Arabic is an advantage
