



Position: Community Accountability Training (Short Term Technical Assistance)

Duration: Estimated timeframe: 3 April – 17 April 2017 (10days)

Background: In September 2015, USAID-South Sudan awarded the Promoting Resiliency through Ongoing Participatory Engagement and Learning (PROPEL) program to Global Communities and partner Catholic Relief Services. This program brings together communities and strengthens their capacity to drive their own development through harnessing their own resources, leveraging other donor-funded programs, and advocating for additional support to implement projects that address priority needs. This program promotes social cohesion and resilience within South Sudanese communities while providing tangible improvements in the lives of community residents. PROPEL is a pilot Collaboration, Learning and Adapting (CLA) project that aims to provide a rigorous evidence base for a unified approach to Community Driven Development (CDD) in South Sudan.

Objective and Scope of Work: An STTA is needed to revise current PROPEL Community Accountability Training material and deliver a pilot training to PROPEL staff in Bor Field Office. The STTA will be responsible for producing all documents related to the training, including but not limited to training manual, agenda, visual aids, and training report. The STTA will work closely with the Sr. Research & Evaluation Specialist, Community Engagement Program Manager, Sr. Manager for Research & Learning, and the MERL team to ensure content is in line with PROPEL's mission and methodology.

Methodology & Timeframe: The STTA is responsible for determining the approach to revising the training material and delivering the training. STTA must physically report to Juba & Bor Office for no less than 6 days of LOE.

Deliverables:

- Revised Community Accountability Training Manual
- Training Agenda and materials
- Conduct training activities in the Bor Field Office
- Community Accountability Training Report
- Any other training related material produced
