Based in Bor**

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Bor.

**Main Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Organizes and manages the implementation and monitoring of agricultural programs and other economic security projects in BRX SD.
- Contributes to the preparation of assessment and monitoring reports, such as initial needs assessment, Post Distribution Monitoring, Post-Harvest Assessment, etc. in a timely manner Plans field trips, help manage SSRC volunteers, participate in distributions, write distribution and stock balance reports, conduct PDM and monitoring and write assessment and evaluation reports not related to agro activities, when needed.
- Participates in establishment and implementation of procedures.
- Ensures follow-up and updates files & databases if required
- Maintains and expands network of interlocutors in the area of responsibility
- Analyses the socio-economic, political and cultural situation of the covered area and its humanitarian consequences for the population.
- Maintains a clear record/ trail of financial advances updating reporting line manager and ensuring timely clearance of working advance
- Assists the EcoSec delegate (s) on any other requested duty and acts as a generalist if needed.

**Minimum Required Skills and Qualifications:**

- University degree in Agricultural science
- Min 3 years' experience in adapted agricultural technology, seed management, plant genetic resources, supervision of on-farm trials, participatory methods and/or in livelihood projects, distributions, and humanitarian assistance related to economic security
- Intermediate level in computer skills
- Skilled in the following competencies: Representing the ICRC; Adapting & Learning; Communication (ability to express and exchange views and ideas); Analysis & Synthesis
- Good knowledge of ICRC mandate, IHL, and of other humanitarian topics
- Knowledge of geographically assigned area desired
- Familiarity with crop production, seed plantation rate and measurement of seed produce and output
- Micro economic/ financial assessment and analysis of crop production
- Ability and readiness to spend 50%-75% of time in the field.
