BOAT CAPTAIN
Based in Old Fangak**

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Old Fangak.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operates a small boat with 50 HP engine in a safe, responsible, accident free manner, and transports people or materials as per the instructions
- Ensures that passengers and cargo on board have all the necessary authorizations and documents available
- Performs field trip checks as per checklist and ensures timely preparation of boat as per standard
- Maintains the boat equipment and reports immediately any need for replacement
- Reports changes in security or river safety situations immediately to his supervisor
- Ensures the boat is fueled in a timely manner
- Ensures cargo is properly loaded (safe weight distribution, covered from the elements)
- Carries out washing and cleaning of the assigned boat
- Reports any damage or missing equipment immediately to the Logistician (including minor scratches)
- Checks on a daily basis the general working and body conditions of the boat and its accessories
- Reports technical defects and or missing equipment immediately to his supervisor
- Checks the mechanical condition of the vessel prior to each trip and at the beginning of all working days: fluid levels, safety equipment, sonar/radio equipment, engine and propulsion system, lights, mooring ropes, bilges and bilge pump operation, inspects for eventual leaking of fuel and oil, checks body condition etc.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Minimum Primary school level
- Driving license with clean record
- Having passed the ICRC driving test
- Minimum 3 years' experience piloting large river boats
- Previous experience co-piloting or working on boats
- Ability to hold simple conversations in English
- Capacity to operate various types of watercraft (multi-engine, propeller driven, water-jet, in-board, out-board engine etc.)
- Knowledge of HF, VHF radio's and general radio procedures
- Mechanical aptitude – ability to carry out or direct others to make basic maintenance and repairs
