**JOB SUMMARY**

To provide effective responsibility of giving training according to CompASS research protocol training including community sensitization and Screening.

**KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

**Research and Data collection**

- Participate in refresher IMAM/CMAM training and original CompAS research protocol training including training on CommCare; must demonstrate understanding of the treatment protocols.
- Implement CMAM Nutrition and CompAS protocol and ensure that all OTP/TSFP CNWs and community mobilizers understand and adhere to its
- Assist in community sensitization and screening to recruit the study participants; through the screening, identify the participants who may need available appropriate referral.
- Plan and conduct mass MUAC screening of the under-five on a quarterly basis in collaboration with the CHWs and Clinic outreach planning.
- On daily basis , work at OTP/TSFP site to recruit children to the study, enrol base on study enrolment criteria and procedures obtain informed consent from the care givers to collect and store the personal data of the study participants.
- On daily basis, implement CompAS research study data collection procedures, record enrolment and weekly follow-up data using m-health software on electronic tablets.
- Register research participate and orient their care givers on the phase / treatment corresponding to their medical/ nutritional status.
- Communicate to care givers of the research participants the key combined and standards protocol messages ensuring that it is appropriately delivered in order to promote adherence to the protocol.
- Collect good quality follow data and confirm data quality before submission.

- Supportive supervise the CNWs and ensure they understand the purpose of the project.

**Ensure well-being of the study participants and their care givers;**

- Ensure that welcoming is properly carried out by CNWs and Community Mobilizers. Maintain a professional and an adapted relation with the beneficiaries/ caretakers.
- Show respect to every child and care takers and use proper way of communication and ensure that the time spent by the beneficiaries in the OTP/TSFP sites is reasonable.
- Through CNWs, trace the study participants who do fail to turn up or default from the project.
- Evaluate the nutritional status and health condition of the ComPAS study participants regularly in collaboration with the medical team.
- Work closely with research officer and Deputy and site nutrition to find or propose ways to improve the program based on the identified needs at the specific OTP/TSFP sites.
- **Supplies Management;**
- Maintain record of ComPAS research study supplies; take stock of supplies that need to be replenished and work with the research officer tp per-position.
- Draw up planning of activities for the CNWs together with the nutrition team according to the needs in consideration of the constraints.
- Check that the mats are clean, are washed and changed regularly and that blankets are available;
- Follow / review CNWs home vist planning for study participants absentee or defaulter
- Professionally collaborate and communicate with the OTP/TSFP site based Nutrition teams.

**QUALIFICATIONS & SKILLS REQUIRED**

- Diploma in Nutrition or clinical studies or Nursing.
- Health related certificate and minimum of 2 (two) years' experience of working in CMAM program is considerable.
- Previous experience in research setting is desirable.
- Technical understanding of CMAM is needed.
- Experience in mobile date collection is preferred and plus.
- Sufficient knowledge of anthropometric measurement and statistics.
- Familiarity with the local language/dialect.
- Good communication skill and ability to influence the community.
- Experience with ACF-USA Nutrition activities.
