**South Sudan Health Association (SSUHA)** formerly known as Sudan Health Association (SUHA) is a National Non-Governmental Organization (NNGO) founded during the Sudan civil war in 1995 to support Sudanese refugees in Kenya and those living in the then liberated areas of Southern Sudan. It however started operating in Kajo-Keji in June 1997 providing basic health services to the community in that county. It is currently registered with the South Sudan Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC)

From the time of its inception, SSUHA has been providing humanitarian services to the needy communities of South Sudan in several fields that include health, HIV/AIDS, food security and livelihood, WaSH, Among other projects, SSUHA is currently implementing Health/Nutrition project funded by Terre Des Hommes (TDH) in Lainya County. It is therefore seeking to recruit for the following position:

### **JOB PUROSE:**

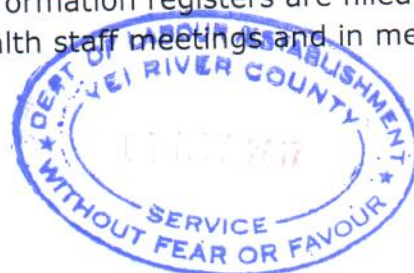
The candidate for this position will represent SSUHA values and principles in interactions with line department and project staff. These values and principles

include: the commitment to the mission, vision & aims of SSUHA, team orientation, quality work, **Stabilization centre nurses and PHCC services at PHCC**

### **Main duties include**

The Nurse is responsible for implementing all the nursing care, health education and promotion activities for both the OPD and IPD patients. He/she shall be responsible for all the activities of Facility In-charge/Clinical Officer in his/her absentia or when delegated as grouped under this level in the MOH guidelines

- Provide nursing care for OPD and IPD patients according to MOH guidelines
- Participates in clerking of patients as well as providing nursing care as required.
- Provides appropriate prescribed treatments as well as counseling of patients to ensure adherence to treatment instructions.
- Provides supportive supervision of nursing staff {CHWs, Auxiliary Nurses} to ensure that they carry out their duties as required.
- Participates in the on-job training of other staff, especially community health workers and auxiliary nurses, and also in organizing sensitization of the community members.
- Provides health education to patients coming to the health facility, and also plan community based health campaigns.
- Participates in conducting of community based health care activities including planned outreaches.
- Participate in clerking of patients as well as providing nursing care as required.
- Provides appropriate prescribed treatments as well as counseling the patients to ensure adherence to treatment instructions
- Participates on provision of antenatal care services and training of traditional birth attendants as might be delegated by the supervisor
- Provides supportive supervision of nursing staff (CHWs and auxiliary nurses) to ensure that they carry out their duties as required
- Participate in the on-job training of other staff especially CHW and auxiliary nurses and also in organizing for sensitization in the health facility
- Provides health education to patients coming to the health facility and also plans community based campaigns
- Participates in EPI activities including vaccinations request of vaccines as well as making of reports
- Participates in conducting of community based health care activities including planned outreaches and school health programs
- Provides daily reports for the admitted patients and also ensures that required health information registers are filled in appropriately
- Participates in health staff meetings and in meetings for village health committees



- Give required feedback or reports on request by supervisors regarding ongoing activities
- Carry out other duties as delegated by the supervisor

**Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience**

- Minimum required qualification is at least Certificate or Diploma in Nursing from a recognized Institution.
- At least 2-3 years of professional experience in Nursing from a busy Hospital
- Willingness to work and move in an insecure and hard to reach areas with minimum supervision
- Fluent in written and spoken English, Arabic and Bari desirable
- Flexibility and willingness to take up any official duty assigned by the supervisor
- Ability to work as an individual and as a team.
- Prepare reports in time and ability to use the reporting tools
