#### **BACKGROUND:**

Mercy Corps has been operational in South Sudan since 2005 and is currently engaged in humanitarian responses. The emergency response program in Unity State provides life-saving support to IDPs and host communities affected by the current fighting. Mercy Corps is well represented in the northern states of South Sudan with field offices in each of these states/areas with its country office in the capital of Juba. In Unity State Mercy Corps has been running different programs from three field offices: Rubkona, Panyijiar and Koch counties. In the three counties WASH is one of the major components of the interventions funded by USAID/OFDA, UNICEF and SSHF. Mercy Corps has strong operational presence in Unity state where the humanitarian needs are vast.

Project Manager is responsible for providing technical support and supervision to all EiE program staff in Panyijiar County (Nyal and Ganyliel) ensuring that program targets are achieved timely in accordance with Mercy Corps quality assurance and accountability principles. Specifically, the Project Manager will contribute towards the achievement of the program objectives through providing leadership to the project team. The Project Manager will also be responsible for fostering and maintaining productive good relationships with education stakeholders in the County.

#### **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Lead the process of developing and implementing project activity plans and ensure timely delivery of project outcomes in an inclusive manner.
- 2. Organize and facilitate meetings with project stakeholders including the community according to principles of inclusion and accountability.
- 3. Represent Mercy Corps in Education coordination forums including cluster and working groups at field level.
- 4. Facilitate training sessions for PTAs, youth, community groups and other project stakeholders
- 5. Carry out field assessments (baseline surveys, midline, end-line, gender assessments monitoring activities).
- 6. Coordinate with other program teams (WASH, FSL, Child Protection) for integrated programing
- 7. Write quality and timely periodic (weekly, monthly, quarterly) project reports.

- 8. Assist the program manager with preparation of periodic program reports for both internal and external audiences.
- 9. Assist with identifying new opportunities in the education sector and contribute to program design processes through written input to concepts notes and proposals
- 10. Ensure systematic tracking of project indicators and collaborate with the Monitoring and Evaluation team for accurate and timely flow of information from the field for entry in the project database
- 11. Ensure project files are maintained professionally as per Mercy Corps minimum program management standards
- 12. Participate in Mercy Corps organized monitoring processes including weekly meetings, quarterly program review, annual program meetings
