The Logistics Site Manager will work closely with the Project Managers and Administrators, taking care of the logistics management of the projects carried out in the area. S/he will cooperate with the administrative and logistics staff based in Juba Country Office.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Oversee the logistics in the assigned duty station, especially concerning movements of people and supplies
- Ensure proper stores management
- Ensure maintenance of CUAMM compound and supported health facilities (Hospitals, PHCCs, PHCUs)
- Oversee construction/rehabilitation works, liaising with contractors or directly managing construction workers hired teams
- Support in the procurement procedure paperwork
