### COUNTRY PROFILE

Operational in South Sudan since 1994, ARC has been implementing multi-sectoral programs that include primary health care, water and sanitation, reproductive health care, HIV/AIDS and gender based violence prevention and response, and activities geared towards creating economic opportunities for returning populations. Since 2013, among other things, ARC has been an Implementing Partner to run a county-wide health service delivery model under USAID funding. ARC has been the lead Implementing Partner in implementing county-wide service delivery model and hospital projects under Health Pool Funding (HPF) in Kapoeta East, Kapoeta South, Kajo-Keji and Magwi Counties and Awil State Hospital and Kapoeta Civil Hospitals. More recently, ARC formed a consortium with other organizations and has been supporting the county-wide health service delivery model under the Health Pooled Fund 2 (HPF2). Following the ongoing fighting that result in displacement of local communities and breakdown of health systems, ARC is staging multi-sectoral response to address the humanitarian needs of Internally Displaced Peoples (IDPs).

### BROAD DESCRIPTION OF THE ROLE

To provide support to ARC's program particularly at the three identified IDP camp in greater Kajo Keji under supervision of the Emergency health and nutrition project coordinator. The post holder will be responsible for mobilizing community to increase access to Immunization services, MCH health, nutrition services and WASH services in collaboration with the CHD, camps leaders, Health committees, the chiefs, HHPs and Health Care facility staff



## OVERALL SCOPE OF THE WORK

- Supervise and support HHPs and other community based health volunteers to mobilize community in the three targeted camps to improve maternal and Child Health care services such as Antenatal care, Post-natal Care , Labor and delivery , Nutrition, WASH and institutional skilled attended deliveries.
- Closely work with community volunteers to increase access to Immunization coverage, Reproductive health services and Family Planning information and services.
- Participate in developing and dissemination of culturally appropriate IEC&BCC
- Encourage and promote growth monitoring by encouraging proper use of child health Road to health child card,
- Monitor and ensure that the road to health chart is completely filled and advise given to the care giver
- Plan and supervise household outreach activities
- Hold bi weekly HHPs meetings and review their reports
- Organize and provide on the job training to HHPs and other community based health agents based on the identified training needs
- Maintain record of activities accurately, consistently and complete for timely reporting and flow from community based intervention to the health facilities, CHD and then to ARC field office.
- Support and strengthen the referral system within the camps to health facilities

### **Supervision and Training**

- Participate actively in the monthly planning of supervision and monitoring activities; and in the monthly debriefing with action plans and recommendations.

### **Collaboration with the CHD**

- Responsible to work with the CHD , health and nutrition supervisor's & health facilities head to update HHPs records at the camps
- In collaboration with health and nutrition supervisor, strengthen the communication between the CHD, health care facilities in charges and community resource persons to ensure proper referral mechanisms are in place for health emergencies.

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## ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND COMPETENCIES

- Diploma in community health from recognized university with Public health and/or social sciences
- Prior experience in implementing Community based interventions
- Experienced in capacity building and facilitating trainings.
- Fluent and clear English speaker with good writing skills.
- Computer skills including MS Excel / Word and Email.
- Experience of working in a team.
- Experience in writing clear and concise reports.
- Knowledge of Kuku is a plus
- Health professionals i.e. enrolled Nurse and Midwives are encouraged to apply
- This position is open to South Sudanese Nationals only.

- Two or more years of proven practical experience in implementing and managing Community based health and health promotion activities.
