



## **Call for Bids-External Audit**

### **Background**

Christian Aid works in South Sudan to bring lasting change to the lives of the poorest conflict affected communities. Christian Aid considers poverty as an outrage against humanity. It robs people of dignity, freedom and hope, of power over their own lives. Christian Aid has a vision – an end to poverty – and we believe that vision can become a reality. We work wherever there is great need, helping people to find their own solutions to the problems they face, irrespective of their religion, caste or creed.

Christian Aid invites detailed proposals from qualified and reputable audit firms to provide audit services as follows;

### **Scope of the work**

- Organizational Audit
  - Auditing annual accounts of the organization (financial year runs from 1<sup>st</sup> April-31<sup>st</sup> March) according to International Standards of Auditing.
- Project Audit
  - Auditing of Christian Aid and donor funded projects.

### **Location**

Organizational audits will be carried out within the head office (Juba) while project audits may vary, both within Juba and field locations of partner organizations that are spread across the country.

### **Indicative Price**

Submit a detailed financial proposal for all fees, based on different budget ranges

### **Technical requirements**

- Experienced and professionally qualified KEY staff (provide CVs).
- Detailed approach on conduct of audits.
- Experience auditing development and humanitarian organizations (NGOs).
- List of recent clients (include recommendations).

### **Other Requirements**

- Legally registered in South Sudan (Provide certificates).
- Demonstrate tax compliance (tax clearance).
- Evidence of an operational Office in Juba.
- Recommendations from current clients.

NB: The successful bidder will be contracted for a period of three years.
