JOB ADVERTISEMENT Welder Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Designs, fabricates, joins, and repairs equipment, fixtures, and structures by using various welding techniques. Welders are called upon to lift and carry heavy objects, and work under conditions of restricted movement, a dirty environment, air contamination, intense noise, and hazardous materials.
- Support the Senior Welder to carry out the preparation and welding of minor modification or new basic steel construction as per sketch, technical drawings, recommendations and technical guidelines given.
- Specifically to master the skill of Arc-Welding from senior welder, understanding the required ICRC standard of metal works, and perform to the level of independency when given a specific task to be completed.
- Welds steel, aluminum and stainless steel components based on the specifications of the blueprints and/or drawings.
- Set up welding machines based on the job at hand or using a Welding Procedure Specification.
- Carry out panel beating and painting activities and assemble items as instructed by supervisor; carry out routine works independently.
- Select the correct specified materials (Electrodes etc.) as per requirement and independently
- Carry out minor planning (sketches, technical drawings) of modifications and constructions.
- Keep the welding workshop, compound and tools always clean, tidy and in proper condition
- Operate machinery used in the production process, or assist machine operators.
- Ensure personal safety when working with equipment, and making sure everyone respect the "safety first" rules; ensure that all workshop safety and security measures & regulations are properly used and respected.
- Ensure the proper disposal of waste, (obsolete spare parts and materials) according to the given Waste Management rules and regulations.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Secondary School education and technical skills or vocational training in construction, maintenance, logistics or any similar technical field.
- 2-4 years experiences in Welding / Construction, in the field of maintenance, mechanics or any similar technical field with eagerness to learn the Arc-Welding mastery.
- Extensive knowledge of construction materials and their characteristic, especially in the field of Metalwork.
- Basic computer knowledge is an added value.
- Highly motivated to work and follow through any project task with the approach of good workmanship.
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning, Team Work, Security Management, Planning, Organization & Assessment; Communication (Ability to express views and ideas)
- Conversational in English and Arabic
