Purpose of the position

The producer will be responsible for scripting and production of 10 scripts in English and Arabic.

In relation to this core responsibility the Producer must:

II. Tasks and responsibilities

Recording the episodes, and managing the production team, will include, but is not limited to:

- Being present in the studio during the recordings of all episodes.
- Planning timing in advance and keeping strictly to schedule, including ensuring the actors are scheduled appropriately
- c. Managing the recordings of the radio dramas
- d. Reviewing the scripts to check for potential technical problems
- e. Actor coordination before and during recording

Scriptwriter

The producer is responsible for assisting in the creative writing process and the script development process for a 10 episode peacebuilding radio drama. This includes the writing of radio drama scripts on the basis of original, creative inputs, imagination, and research, structured advice from partners and peers.
