1. BACKGROUND

The government of the Republic of South Sudan has received a grant of UA1 million from the African Development Bank to finance the project of Institutional Support to Good Governance and Capacity Building in Natural Resources Management in the Ministry of Environment and Forestry of the Government of the Republic of South Sudan. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this grant will be applied to eligible payments under contract for Consultancy Services for sector Study. The estimated duration of these services is four (04) months and the expected commencement of the assignment is 15/10/2017.

1.2 Main Objective of the Consultancy:

Provide support to the evolution of inclusive policies and strategies for the sustainable management of forestry resources in South Sudan through institutional capacity building and sector management information system development.

This study requires a consultant to guide sectors dealing with natural/forestry resources, identify and prioritize policy changes required for conservation and sustainable utilization of resources in complaints with United Nations framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
