- Assist WASH Manager in developing WASH Sector technical approaches, implementation guidelines and tools and promote implementation.
- Undertake periodic project monitoring and provide technical backstopping.
- Ensure that sector budgets are aligned to project designs and DIPs.
- Participate in Building the capacity of CMD staff to plan, implement, monitor and evaluate WASH programs.
- Assist to follow up and ensure that projects adhere to set sector standards (donor, government, cluster, etc)
- Support in sourcing and providing contextual analysis to inform WASH strategy and programming.

Reporting and communication

- Prepare project documentation including weekly and monthly project reports on implementation/ construction status, as per requirements of CMD
- Liaise closely to WASH Sector Head and other relevant team members for review/further action.
- Liaison with WASH Project Manager, Finance and Grants team in tracking WASH component project expenditure, reviewing financial reports, and following up queries of related expenditure in timely manner.

- Excellent understanding of WASH programmatic activities in South Sudan
- At least 2years experience and skills in supervision of infrastructural construction works using community groups, civil society groups and contractors.
- At least 2years' experience in supervision of construction/rehabilitation of emergency water supplies basic Sanitation facilities in a large displaced community set up.
- Experience in coordination and supervision of sanitation and household refuse/waste management using community-based approaches.
- Experience in designing and implementing WASH facilities eg HH Latrine, bathing Shelters, Emergency water supplies and hygiene promotion for affected people in displacement camps and settlement.

- Understands and has implemented PHAST and other participatory methodologies.
- Demonstrated experience in mainstreaming WASH into other sector programs within humanitarian settings.
