Purpose of the position:

To ensure successful implementation of health interventions in the designated health facilities and outreach points in Renk County, Through a close collaboration with the State Ministry of Health (SMOH), County Health Departments (CHD) and facility health committees. The County Health Coordinator reports to the Project Manager and will provide supervision and direction to Health services, facilitating good practices and ensuring compliance with applicable implementation policy guidelines, standards and processes of health interventions and the project priorities including planning, implementation, monitoring and follow up.

Major Roles and Responsibilities of position

- Capacity building of health facility staff through short-term in-service trainings or active on-job mentoring
- Ensure Quality of Care practices are promoted and entrenched in health facilities
- Compile and/ or review and analyze health program data and share with on a monthly basis
- Plan and train clinical staff on IMNCI, IPC and drug management
- Compile and analyze World Vision South Sudan internal and donor reports as per Donor requirements and guidelines
- Review health program budgets and financial reports, providing feedback on actions required for each Grant.
- Review program performance as per targets agreed on the Log Frame and suggest any remedial actions necessary to enhance program delivery

- Represent WVSS in partner/cluster/donor meetings as applicable, including presentations on program progress.
- Supervision and monitoring of health service delivery, compiling reports of such monitoring visits and follow up actions
- Ensure pharmaceutical supplies and other essential commodities are available in health facilities, including timely orders for buffer stocks as appropriate
- Develop and maintain an active health program database that captures program deliverables and shows a clear patterns of clear program performance
- Participate in training organized by WV/ other partner's as agreed with your line Manager
- Perform any other duty as assigned by the supervisor.

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Higher Diploma in Clinical Medicine (Clinical Officer) with more than four (4) years of field experience. Post basic training in any of the following (Pediatrics, MCH) is an added advantage
- Registered Nurse with strong clinical background and knowledge/practice of midwifery may also be considered
- Individuals with BSc in Public Health and strong evidence of active clinical practice should apply
- An active clinician able to mentor nurses, midwives and medical assistants on job.
- Must be trained on IMNCI and PMTCT and able to conduct similar trainings to health facilities staff
- Knowledge of basic Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care and IPC is a plus
- Good understanding of the treatment Guidelines of South Sudan and Essential Medicines List
- Professional knowledge of computer use (Word, Excel and Power point)
- A good understanding of the Project Management Cycle
- Ability to engage Government Authorities (State Ministries, County Health Departments, and County Authorities) is required.
