ERT WASH Technician

Job Purpose: Contribute to the implementation, management, and supervision of Medair's WASH Emergency Response Programme.

A. Key Responsibilities.

1. Technical

- Ensure timely and quality construction and/or rehabilitation of water and sanitation infrastructure as appropriate for the community served.
- Participate in the planning and implementation of WASH needs assessments amongst target communities.
- Appropriately involve the beneficiary population in all phases of the projects.
- Seek for the continual improvement of both the technical implementation and the processes of the WASH programme.
- Conduct exit survey at the end of each intervention
- Collect beneficiary feedback and complaint during the entire time of the project
- Conduct water testing

2. Quality Management

- Ensure a high standard of work at all times, aiming to achieve SPHERE standards or better for all interventions.

3. Communication

- Provide regular field reports to the Project Manager or PM by email, telephone or HF radio communication and contribute to writing assessment and intervention reports.

4. Staff Management (in the field)

- Hire and manage casual labourers for the construction and rehabilitation of WASH infrastructure
- Act as team leader when requested

5. Logistics/Finance

- Provide logistics support as necessary, management of stock and team finances when needed.

6. Monitoring and Evaluation

- Work alongside Medair Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) staff to establish tracking and reporting mechanisms for Medair WASH ERT Interventions

7. Protection Mainstreaming

- Take part in joint evaluation and planning sessions between Medair and the community to actively identify protection concerns
