## Armed Forces and Security (FAS) / Communication Officer Bentiu Sub Delegation (temporarily based in Juba)

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position working for Bentiu Sub delegation and temporarily based in Juba until the reopening of the Sub Delegation office in Bentiu town.

## Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Represents the ICRC at his/her level of expertise (dissemination, training of arms carriers).
- Provides training sessions to officers of the Armed Forces and armed groups at Division, Brigade, Battalion and at the lower field level without supervision.
- Organizes trainings, workshops and meetings under the direction of his/her supervisor, applying relevant administrative and logistics procedures.
- Develops, sustains and leverages a network of contacts with the military, police and security forces, with a view . of promoting knowledge and implementation of International Humanitarian Law (IHL).
- Develops expertise on implementation and promotion of IHL and supports the work of the Sub-Delegation in all . matters relating to the implementation of IHL.
- Conducts and organizes operational communication sessions with non-military audiences.
- Initiates and prepares analytical documents on developments within the military and armed groups and how . they relate to the ICRC work, and reports on security issues relevant for the ICRC.
- Contributes to the scanning and analysis of the socio-political, economic and humanitarian environment.
- Provides written reports on training sessions, monitoring trips and other activities as required, and compiles monthly consolidated statistical reports for the Communication Department.
- Contributes to the preparation of timely reports as required on the target groups (Com Report, Field Reports, Weekly Highlight/Operational Reports, Monthly Reports, etc).
- Contributes, interpretation and translation.

## Minimum Required Skills and Qualifications:

- Bachelor Degree or equivalent higher education degree, preferably in a social science.
- Sound understanding of military structures in South Sudan (SPLA and other armed groups).
- Prior experience (3 years) in the humanitarian field, law, communication, information, journalism, publishing or . similar position; involving networking and maintaining relations.
- First-rate oral communication and interpersonal skills; ability to adapt to and connect with military audiences. .
- Good knowledge of ICRC mandate and activities. Sound knowledge of International Humanitarian Law (IHL). . .
- Fluency in English and Arabic (Juba Arabic), Nuer or Dinka (spoken and written).
- Good computer skills.
- The position is 70%-80% field based. The candidate needs to be willing to spend most of the time in the field (former Unity State).
