Job title: Freelance/Casual Actors

BBC Media Action uses media and communications to reduce poverty and promote human rights in developing countries. To achieve this, it partners with civil society, local media and governments to:

- Strengthen the media sector through building professional capacity and infrastructure.

BBC MA in South Sudan is looking for freelance actors to take part in an episodic radio drama programme. The theme of the story is peaceful conflict resolution. The casual actors will work full-days or half-days as and when required by the organisation's drama Director. **This is occasional work only**, with a maximum requirement of one day per week as needed.

The successful applicants will have excellent reading and writing ability in **any of the following languages**: Nuer, Dinka or simple Arabic; as well as strong spoken English skills, and a flair for making their audiences believe in their characters.

Open auditions for Dinka-speaking actors will take place on Wednesday 22nd November in Tongping between 09:15 AM and 16:30 PM.

Open auditions for Arabic-speaking actors will take place on Thursday 23rd November in Tongping between 09:15 AM and 16:30 PM.

Open auditions for Nuer-speaking actors will take place on Friday 24th November at a location to be confirmed.
