Purpose of the position:

The overall purpose of this position is to organize, mobilize, promote, monitor and evaluate basic hygiene and sanitation situation in Warrap region in collaboration with relevant local government sector staffs and target communities (IDPs, returnees and vulnerable residents) and enhancing hygiene and sanitation practices in the project area.

Major Roles and Responsibilities

- Assess, organizes, and mobilizes community for the hygiene promotion campaign. Maintain good periodic records for basic environment health services
- · Maintain work relationship with local partners and create smooth work atmosphere
- Assess and identify community health committees capacity and facilitates capacity building
- Ensure timely submission of periodic reports weekly and monthly
- Ensure that good care (good hygiene standards) are maintained in the water points
- Ensures the profiles of community volunteer health committee workers in the operation area and assess
