Organization background

The Confident Children out of Conflict (CCC) is a national organization founded in 2007 as a response to the needs of orphaned, other vulnerable street children and young adult women. Many of these children were staying at the cemetery sites, salakana, gumbo, rakubas, Mahad, Lologo, Korbou.

CCC provides 100 Children with shelter, food and clean water and education and another 766 children at community settings to go t school. These kids are here to be helped to develop, go to school, and learn some entrepreneurship skills in order to help themselves, their families and community at large. Without this care, these children would remain on the streets, unproductive, exploited sexually, subjected to early marriages, child labour, trafficking and all sorts of Gender based violence.

Overall role

Responsible for assisting the Case Manager in conducting follow-ups and referrals to services, monitors and coordinate referral pathway with partners and beneficiaries, ensure information updates and adhere to confidentiality.

Major Roles and Responsibilities

- Identify and assess eligible beneficiaries for project activities;
- Responsible for conducting follow-ups and referrals to services providers using applicable tools;
- Guarantee constant follow-up on cash for documentation cases;
- Assist the CM in monitoring and provision of services and closure of cases;
- Assist the CM to provide accurate and detailed legal protection counseling services;
- Deliver updated information sessions and individual counseling to the project beneficiaries;
- Support the monitor pathways by working closely with Field Officers;
- Support the day-to-day data collection and data entry of field outcomes;
- Participates in field mapping exercises and be aware of changes to NGO community;
- Coordinate referrals pathways with partner agencies of project beneficiaries;
- Ensures protection mainstreaming in field activities, including identification of cases for referrals;
- Share trends and observations from the field;

- Contribute to the monthly, quarterly and annual Confident Children out of Conflict narrative reports for the project to be submitted to CM.
