JOB OPENING Health Field Officer Bentiu Sub Delegation (temporarily based in Juba)

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position working for Bentiu Sub delegation and temporarily based in Juba until the reopening of the Sub Delegation.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Under the supervision of the Head of Sub Delegation, the employee contributes to the implementation and monitoring of the first aid program;
- Principal First Aid Trainer for the Sub Delegation;
- Focal point for Physical Rehabilitation Program (PRP) in the Sub Delegation's area of responsibility;
- Independently accomplishes routine tasks;
- Contributes to the written reports on the health events and to the production of minutes of meetings;
- Maintains an established network of contacts with interlocutors on technical aspects;
- Updates and maintains the interlocutors lists/ database;
- Ensures proper distribution of ICRC publications to the target audience;
- Presents and explains, to the target communities and beneficiaries, the ICRC mandate, principles and activities implemented in South Sudan.

Minimum Required Skills and Qualifications:

- Experience in conducting First Aid trainings.
- Health background with some clinical knowledge
- Ability to work independently
- Strong sense of responsibility
- Proven organizational skills and ability to take initiative
- Team spirit
- Good facilitation skills: Able to carry out trainings and explanations in front of a large audience
- Can demonstrate patience, perseverance, adaptability and independence.
- Fluent in Arabic and English (both oral and written), knowledge of local languages an asset
- Interprets in any situation with accuracy. Treats information confidentially.
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning; Communication (ability to express and exchange views and ideas and to package messages for different audiences), with an outgoing personality
- Good knowledge of the ICRC mandate
- Good knowledge of geographically assigned environment (Ruweng, Northern Liech and Southern Liech State)
