JOB OPENING Health Field Officer - Midwife Based in Waat

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent Organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Waat.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Contributes to the planning, implementation, and monitoring of Primary Health Care activities (including maternal and child Health) in the Sub delegation.
- Supports and develops skills in management of all activities in the Primary Health Care Unit.
- Complies with Ministry of Health (MOH) guidelines and protocols in the Primary Health Care Unit.
- Ensures the antenatal attendants receive insecticide treated mosquito nets and clean delivery kits at the appropriate time and that clear records are kept.
- Is responsible for identifying pregnancy related risks and communicates them to his or her hierarchy immediately.
- Attends meetings that pertain to the Primary Health Care Unit including maternal and child health and Victims of Sexual violence.
- Plans and conducts regular Traditional Birth Attendants meetings and trains them on recognition of danger signs, reporting, care of victims of sexual violence and early referral.

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- Qualification: registered Nurse-Midwife.
- Experience in Primary Health Care Programs (including safe motherhood, nutrition, expanded programs of immunization).
- Good training and facilitation skills.
- Experience in care for Victims of Sexual Violence (VSV) is an asset.
- Good level in computer skills including Excel.
- Fluent in English and Arabic.
- Previous experience with an international humanitarian organization is an asset.
