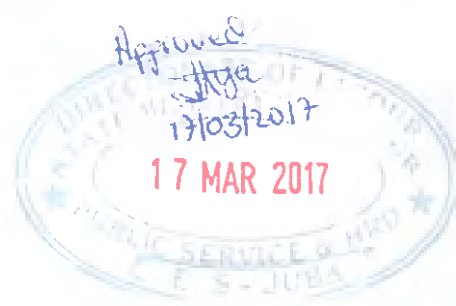

JOB OPENING AGRONOMIST II Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Juba.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Pre and post distribution monitoring, assessment and reporting.
- Pre and post-harvest assessment and reporting.
- Planning and distribution of agricultural seeds and tools; technical familiarity with seeds and tools relevant to the context.
- Familiarity with crop production, seed plantation rate and measurement of seed produce and output.
- Micro economic / financial assessment and analysis of crop production.
- Coordinate activities and response with other primary and secondary stakeholders.
- Attends and represents ICRC at relevant external coordination meetings as advised by EcoSec Delegate.
- Assist EcoSec delegate(s) in the Equatorias in the implementation and management of non-agro Economic Security activities as needed. Activities likely to include: general food distributions, Non-Food Items (NFI) and fishing kit distributions, livestock activities, etc.
- Plan field trips, help manage South Sudan Red Cross volunteers, participate in distributions, write distribution and stock balance reports, conduct Post Distribution Monitoring (PDM) and monitoring and write assessment and evaluation reports not related to agro activities, when needed.
- Translate for the delegates when needed and help with communication with interlocutors and beneficiaries in the field;

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- University degree in Agricultural science or other professional post-secondary school course or diploma in Agricultural science (at least one year full time);
- Minimum 3 years' experience in adapted agricultural technology, seed management, plant genetic resources, supervision of on-farm trials, participatory methods and/or in livelihood projects, distributions, and humanitarian assistance related to economic security;
- Intermediate level in computer skills;
- Very good knowledge of English languages both written and oral;
- Skilled in the following competencies: Representing the ICRC, Adapting & Learning, Communication (ability to express and exchange views and ideas), Analysis & Synthesis;
- Good knowledge of ICRC mandate, IHL, and of other humanitarian topics;
- Very good knowledge of language and geography of assigned area desired;
- Ability and readiness to work in all of Lakes State.
