### **Vacancy Announcement**

World Relief is an International Non-governmental Christian Humanitarian and Development Organization, which works in communities with the Church to transform the lives of the most vulnerable socially, economically and spiritually. WR has been operating in South Sudan since 1998 providing humanitarian assistance to the vulnerable communities affected by the armed conflict and war.

World Relief South Sudan is looking for suitable qualified South Sudanese National to fill the following vacancy:

**Position:** Midwife  
**Reports to:** Health County Coordinator  
**Duty station:** Koch / Mayom

### **Overall Function:**

Under the direct supervision of the facility in-charge, the Midwife will manage MCH clinic and supervise all the TBAs within the covered area.

### **Specific Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Conduct daily antenatal clinic sessions and ensure all pregnant women receive routine medications.
- Assess for high risk conditions in pregnancy and manage appropriate or hence refer.
- Provide appropriate birth preparedness counselling to all pregnant women.
- Ensure all necessary drugs and materials for antenatal, delivery and postnatal care services do not run out of stock at all times.
- Ensure the delivery room is always clean and items ready for emergency delivery.
- Encourage mothers to deliver at the health clinic at all times if circumstances do not allow.
- Conduct safe and clean delivery, taking it to consideration mother privacy and universal infection control.
- Manage referrals from the TBAs/ community.
- Record maternal and neonatal deaths and report them monthly.
- Provide early detection of complication during or after delivery, manage and organize timely referral.
- Encourage the participation and support of the family members during birth to promote support to mother and enhance both mother and the baby bonding and family relationship.
- Conduct regular postnatal care for mothers after delivery.
- Ensure all postpartum mothers receive Vitamin A dose.

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- Promote exclusive breast feeding among lactating mothers.
- Participate in health education delivery at the PHCCs and community.
- Perform other related duties as may be assigned.

### **Qualifications and Experience:**

- Diploma in midwifery from a recognized midwifery training school.
- Previous working experience with International NGOs in the similar position is a plus.
- Very good command of written and spoken Arabic and English.
- Willing to work in remote areas where World Relief is operating.
- Ready to sign and adhere to the WRSS Health Operating Procedure (HOP)
- Applicants must be South Sudanese nationals

### **Application Requirements:**

Applicants desiring consideration for this position should submit the following:

- Application letter, expressing your motivation for the position you are applying for
- Current CV, Copies of diplomas and certificates, including nationality certificate
- List of three former supervisors who can serve as job references one of whom should be from the church with their **valid email addresses and contact numbers**
