Purpose of the position:

Support and maintain the day-to-day operation of WV South Sudan's field-based information and telecommunication systems, through the provision of client-oriented service

- Deployment, maintenance and administration of field-based telecommunications systems and infrastructure (VSATs, Satellite phones, HF and VHF Radio equipment)
- Enforcing telecommunications/security policies and standards in the field
- Establishing a consultative relationship with the Zonal/County Management and the ICT Manager related to provision of ICT services, and ensuring provision of quality and timely ICT support services to the zonal field sites
- In liaison with the National Office:
- Maintenance and repair of field-based IT equipment
- Deployment of client applications to the field users
- Maintenance of the IT assets database for the field sites
- Provide technical advice to the Zonal/County Management and the ICT Manager in decisions relating to the strategic use and implementation of inter-network infrastructure for the field
- Make recommendations to the Zonal/County Management and the ICT Manager on the acquisition of new technologies for the field sites and the deployment of existing ones.
- Providing monthly reports, outlining the achievements for the month (against the planned activities and further against the department's annual operational plan)
