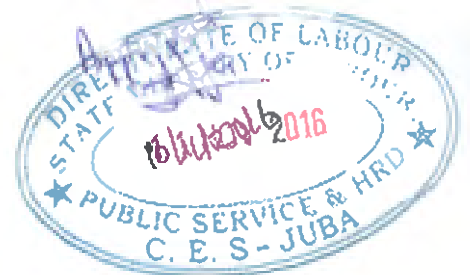

JOB OPENING FIELD OFFICER II Based in Bor AoR

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent Organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Bor AoR.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Acts as a source of information regarding his/her AoR for the Field Delegates and other departments, advising them in their networking activities. Participates in the analysis of the environment and has good mapping of all relevant stakeholders.
- Represents the institution in an appropriate way during activities in the field and during meetings, and avoids any activity that may reflect negatively on the ICRC's image.
- Supports the specialist teams (Ecosec, Wathab, and Health) in their activities in his/her AoR.
- Coordinates with the cooperation department in his/her activities linked to the SSRC and contributes to the implementation of cooperation objectives and programs.
- Supports in the promotion of Basic IHL to communities.
- Participates and contributes in the monitoring of assistance activities.

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- Bachelor degree, some college coursework completed, an Associate Degree or equivalent higher education degree in a humanitarian area, socio-economic development, humanitarian law, human rights or equivalent field.
- Additional vocational training in a humanitarian area, socio-economic development, humanitarian law, human rights or equivalent field.
- 4-6 years of experience in a humanitarian area, socio-economic development, humanitarian law, human rights or similar position,
- Advanced conversational in English and Arabic (other local languages are assets).
- Expert level in computer skills.
- Skilled in the following competencies: representing the ICRC, networking and communication, adapting and learning, responsibility and autonomy, communication (ability to express and exchanges views and ideas), analysis and synthesis.
- Good knowledge of ICRC mandate, IHL and the other humanitarian topics.
- Readiness to spend 50-75% of the time in the field
