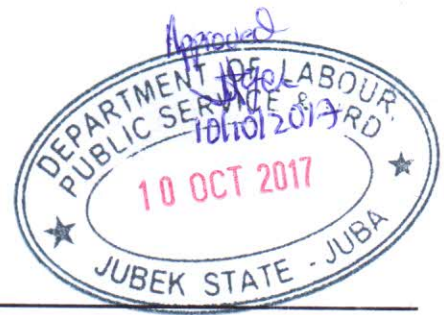

Country Program overview

Health Action Aid is a national non-governmental organization , registered and incorporated under chapter 3, section 10 of South Sudan NGOs’ Act, 2016 with the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) in 2017. Health Action Aid headquarter is located in Juba and will potentially scale up to other parts of the country. There are five(5) key programs in the Organization; Maternal child Health(MCH), HIV/AIDs and TB, Malaria, Nutrition and WASH. Integrated community case management(ICCM) is the primary model of intervention and it’s tailored at both facility and community level following the South Sudan Boma Health Initiative(SSBHI). South Sudan is one of the most underdeveloped countries in the world. Many years of chronic civil wars with Sudan, and internal conflicts before and after the independence eroded the physical and social infrastructure that among other things resulted into destruction and collapse of the health system. As a result, the overall structural framework for delivery of health care services to the entire population particularly, neonatal, maternal and child health services to the entire population in the country was greatly disrupted.

As a non-profit organization, Health Action Aid (HAA) is established to address these challenges with a vision to provide sustainable health interventions through provision of comprehensive health services, focusing on identified health gaps that undermine human development; and to reduce the vulnerability of children and mothers in South Sudan.

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Medical officers will be assigned to PHCCs in the communities that are in need of health care workers to provide health and development assessment and advice. He /she is also tasked with training and working with the nursing team to provide clinical guidance, hands-on training, and educational support on how to properly handle patients under their care in terms of medical support. The medical officer is further responsible for promotive, preventive and curative care services

Scope of Work:

- Examine, diagnose and treat patients in accordance with national guidelines and protocol
- assessment of patient condition, maintaining clinical notes, and taking the necessary actions (consultations and diagnosis)
- prescribe medicines and advise patients based on their conditions to ensure the highest possible standards of patient care needed;
- perform urgent medical services like stabilization, assessment and diagnosis, and/or immediate resuscitation when necessary, and perform treatment and referral to a specialist if necessary;
- recommending treatment options for appropriate intervention and procedure like minor surgeries when necessary and prescribing medicines, advising, and educating patients through counseling or psychological interventions guided by the standard protocol;
- establish and maintain teamwork and cooperation with other health care providers to ensure patients receive maximum benefit from coordinated care;
- examine and review patients at the request of consultants, initiate treatment as necessary, and inform consultants of any changes in the condition of patients; and
- be up to date of new developments in the field of medicine and corresponding literature, skills, and technology to respond to changes in medical procedures and work environment.
- Anticipate changing needs and emergencies. Be prepared to participate in responding to emergencies and disasters at all time

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Requirements:

- Diploma in medical studies from a recognized institution preferably clinical medicine and surgery. An (MD or MBChB or MBBS) is an added advantage .
- At least 1 year of work experience after graduation. A Registration with the medical board/council of the country of origin is an added advantage
- Excellent management and personnel skills to enable the motivation, encouragement and participation of other health team members
