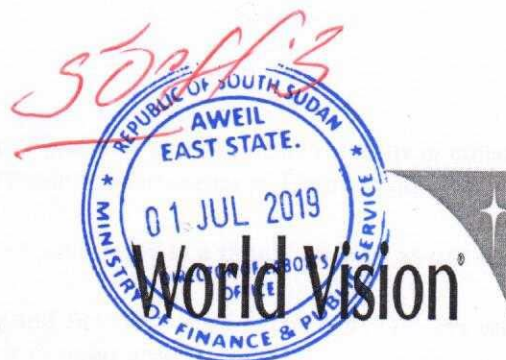

Purpose of the position:

The Food security Officer will offer strategic leadership and management capabilities to Food Security– Agricultural production and advise management on strategically critical areas to be noted for programming benefits and avoidance of obstacles. With a proven track record in a fast paced, complex and ideally global organization, a desire, motivated by Christian faith, to help others and model ethics in line with the Christian foundations and ethos of the organization.

Major Roles and Responsibilities

- Envision, Plan and actualize programs that will enhance Food Security and Livelihoods in NBeG in collaboration with stake holders through increasing acreages cultivated at house hold level, increasing yields per acre through use on better agronomic, skills transfer and use of superior Genotypes and phenotypes.
- Work with the sector lead, NBeG team and Government officials to prioritize crop production and other food security strategies in the region.
- Offer leadership in the implementation of the sector activities by ensuring that the program inputs are available in the right quality, quantity on time and in usable condition.
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- To supervise and coordinate the implementation of livelihood projects/interventions in collaboration with partners and link World Vision with the line government departments at County and state level and other partners at the local cluster level
- Ensure that FSL project activities and outputs are implemented in a timely manner as per the detailed implementation plan.
- To technically mentor and supervise Food security and Assistant food Security 10 Officers working under his supervision. Also carry review staff performance reviews and appraisal
- Ensure high quality Food security and livelihood reports are submitted in a timely manner and work closely with the project officers to ensure reports meet donor requirements.
- Establish transparent relationships with all partners including beneficiaries; identify their priorities and concerns and managing expectations.
- Responsible for monitoring the impact of the project, support decision making and promote learning through documentation of best practices and follow up of necessary adjustment (Change management).
- Identify gaps at the field level and share with the Programme development officers for developing proposal and interventions in the area.

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- A first Degree in Agronomy or Soil Science and an Advanced degree in Agronomy are required.
- Must have at least five years' work experience of which two must have been in Agriculture, Food Security and livelihoods programming in the Non Profit Sector.
- Knowledge of Agriculture Research including adaptive research trials is an advantage.
- Fluency in English in both written and spoken forms is a must
- Should have an in-depth understanding of Food security and livelihoods, operational planning, time scheduling and creative problem solution.
- Excellence in public relations, conflict resolution, interpersonal relationship initiation development and management is a pre-requisite.
- Fluency in English and Arabic required
- Additional qualities: ability to multi-task, ability to handle pressure well, ability to improvise, flexibility, adaptability to transition.
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- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English. Having demonstrated organizational, interpersonal and communication skills;
