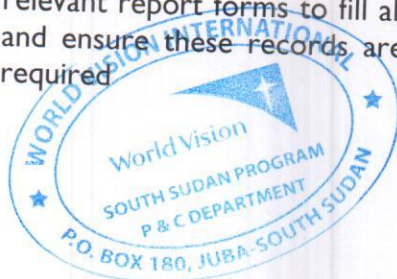
Job Title: Nutrition Assistant
Reporting to: Nutrition Project Coordinator
Location: Juba, South Sudan

Purpose of the position:

To implement the Community based Management of Acute Malnutrition Programme – CMAM through identification and treatment of malnourished cases, monitor progress of the cases to discharge

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Take active roles in identification of malnourished cases through anthropometric measurements
- Work closely and support with Nutrition Nurses at the Nutrition centres to treat and follow up cases of acute malnutrition
- Ensure that the Criteria for admission and discharge are followed and maintained as per national guidelines/WHO and Sphere standards
- Periodic monitoring of the OTP activities in the center
- Participate actively during the Nutrition Assessments i.e. nutrition survey and rapid assessments whenever required.
- Work closely with food aid team in monitoring the trend of acute malnutrition for the vulnerable groups i.e. under five children, pregnant and lactating mothers using the required standard protocols and tools.
- Prepare a **weekly and Bi weekly reports** of children, pregnant and lactating mothers who are enrolled in the program (Admitted, cured, defaulter, absentee etc)
- Keep and maintain use of the register books, individual cards, take home cards and other relevant report forms to fill all the beneficiary information and all data required as per protocol and ensure these records are updated regularly and well-kept in the proper filling system as required



Qualification: Education/Knowledge/technical skills & experience required:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Holder of Diploma or certificate in Nutrition studies
- Must have 3 years' experience in relief commodity management, Nutrition programming & Management, and Nutrition survey and assessments.
- Willing to work under extreme hardship with limited resources.
- Must possess excellent oral and written communication skills in the English language and knowledge of the local Arabic language

Interested candidates who meet the above criteria should submit their applications which shall include a cover letter, together with an updated CV with at least three referees with their telephone and email contacts.
