Position Summary:

Under the direct supervision of the Deputy Chief of Party, the Data Analyst and GIS/Information Management Specialist will create cartographic & visualization products; compile and manage geospatial data, conduct geospatial analysis for inclusion in report and presentations. The Data Analyst and GIS/Information Management Specialist will work with the program team to consolidate the data collection.

The initial period of performance for this position of short term technical assistance is four months, from June to September 2019 with the possibility of extension depending on donor funding.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in tool development, deployment, and data management for third-party monitoring activities using mobile data collection tools
- Create cartographic products using data collected for monitoring, evaluations, studies, and assessments
- Meet with users to define requirements for and construct data visualizations using an open source business intelligence tool.
- Work with the TPM Team to clean monitoring data and facilitate the collection of geo-location data
- Undertake other tasks as assigned by the assignment manager and/or team lead for the successful completion of the assignment.

- A minimum of five (5) years of experience in the collection and analysis of qualitative and quantitative data
