<b>Tasks &amp; responsibilities</b>	<p>The Hygiene Promoter has key activities &amp; responsibilities to achieve this objective:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meeting with local leaders and community elders to communicate the details of overall ACF program objectives and specific WASH program objectives</li> <li>• Organizing Village/ Boma meetings to discuss and communicate details of specific projects</li> <li>• Assessment and selection of villages for implementation of PHAST and CHAST methodology together with hygiene supervisor.</li> <li>• Planning and implementation of teachers training.</li> <li>• Promote the use of household latrines and identify beneficiaries for the program from target villages.</li> </ul>
<b>Objective 2</b>	<b>Organize Health and Hygiene Promotion Campaigns</b>
<b>Tasks &amp; responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Organize health and hygiene campaigns in selected schools including, but not exclusive to, activities like; Hygiene Education Games, Poster competitions, Street/interactive theatre, Singing competitions, Hygiene Promotion Rally's, Hand Washing Demonstrations and Toilet Use Demonstrations. Separate activities are to be organized for girls and boys when necessary.</li> </ul> <p>Organize health and hygiene campaigns in selected villages and undertake activities including; Community Hygiene promotion meetings, Interactive theatre, transect walks, community mapping, Hand washing demonstrations, household latrine promotions, water handling trainings, household water treatment demonstrations and Oral Rehydration Therapy demonstrations.</p>
<b>Objective 3</b>	<b>Demonstrations and Oral Rehydration Therapy demonstrations and participate in surveys and other and monitoring exercises.</b>
<b>Tasks &amp; responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Formation/ reactivation of Water User Committees in all water points constructed/ rehabilitated by WASH technical team</li> <li>• Mobilizing community contributions for the construction activities like sand, gravel, labour etc.</li> <li>• Organizing Water Point Management training for Water User Committees and Care Takers in coordination with the WASH technician team</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Formation and training of hygiene clubs in all the schools targeted under the ACF programs</li> <li>• Participate in KAP surveys and other survey exercises organized by WASH and other departments on the request of the Program Manager</li> <li>• Assist in data collection for monitoring of water points and other projects according to the monitoring schedule available</li> <li>• Familiarise with the data collection formats created as part of the project and use them accordingly</li> </ul>
