Purpose of the position

The Community Mobilizers will be focused and provide a day to day support to the Project Officer in the implementation of Cross Boarder -strengthening the livelihoods Resilience of Pastoral and Agro-Pastoral communities-based project by mobilising and sensitising the community on animal health initiatives, diversification of Agro-pastoral livelihood at Kapoeta East and Kapoeta Counties in Eastern Equatoria. In particular, the community mobilisers are key person in engaging the community activities, supervise community animal health worker CBAHW and community groups, support the project officer to facilitate training at community level and participate in various assessment and survey as well as coordination at Boma, Payam and county level.

In collaboration with the Project Officer, She/he also plays a key role in monitor, identification and registration of the project beneficiaries and report livestock-based livelihood programming, identification of support needed and assistance in the design and implementation of livelihood-based interventions in the livestock sector, community mobilization, sensitising community in natural resources management early warning system and etc

He/she will be based within the communities involving all the groups including women and youth, community leaders, herdsman to support and sensitize constantly the community members in project implementation

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Responsibilities and Accountabilities

- Support Project Officer to develop, implement and monitor programmatic and capacity building
 plans to transfer expertise to community mobilizers and target beneficiaries, focussing on specialist
 thematic area of responsibility
- 2. Strong focus and impact on program delivery, expected to build and maintain strong relationships with stakeholders and relevant associated county, Payam and Boma authorities
- 3. Assist in development of solutions to diverse and complex problems, and develop and implement solutions to more routine problems and issues
- Support the CAHW in the carrying out their duties effectively and report any livestock disease outbreak for action to be taken
- Mobilize Pastoral and Agro pastoral community on the importance of livestock vaccination and disease treatment.
- 6. Sensitize pastoral and the community on the girl right to access education.
- 7. Mobilize, identify and register the project beneficiaries and creation of Agro pastoral Farmers Field Schools AFFS
- 8. Assist project officer in facilitation of training and community awareness on importance of livestock vaccination and disease identification and treatment
- 9. Assist in identifying the priorities for future support programs for livestock-based initiatives in the project area.
- Prepared field activities report (monthly and weekly) and submit to the project office the project officer.
- 11. Work in an environment that is politically and potentially physically insecure, with a high risk of humanitarian crises
- 12. Attend to other duties as directed and instructed by the line Manager.
