Location: Melut, South Sudan Availability: As soon as possible

Purpose of the position:

The Livestock Officer will provide operational operational and technical oversight in the livestock vaccination and treatment programs supported by WV in Melut and Renk and other locations within South Sudan as required. The position will provide supportive supervision to the local government ministry staff on key veterinary activities ensuring effective knowledge transfer and capacity building.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Support the development of frameworks and protocols on the control and prevention of Trans boundary animal diseases and other livestock related issues between South Sudan the neighbouring Countries;
- Support with the development of technical, analytical, monitoring and reporting frameworks;
- Assist with the exploration of options to initiate the establishment of a cost recovery systems and private sector in the animal health services;
- Provide input in development of proposals, work plans and reports required for the purposes
 of annual planning, resource mobilization, and collaboration with partners and reporting to
 donors, etc.
- In Collaboration with Veterinary staff from Department of Veterinary services guide and supervise auxiliary staff and community animal Health workers during livestock vaccination, treatment

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- Provide technical input to livestock-related strategies to partners and food security sector
- Participate in livestock situation analysis/assessments and livestock disease outbreaks investigations in a given area;
- Support design and conducting of epidemiological studies/surveys in the zones
- Development of training materials, design training courses, curriculum and related training materials for Community animal Health workers, producer organizations and livestock owners;
- Undertake directly and coordinate the training community based animal Health workers and livestock owners in the field;
- Ensure the quality and standards of trainings conducted are met.

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

- Must have at least Bachelor of Science degree in Veterinary Science from a recognized University
- Have a five (5) experience veterinary work in pubic or humanitarian work in Southern Sudan
- Excellent computer skills, familiarity with MS Word, Lotus Notes, MS Excel and Power Point would be an added advantage.
- Fluency in English both written and spoken is a must. Ability to speak Arabic is also an added advantage.
- Should have an in-depth understanding of Food security and livelihoods, operational planning, time scheduling and creative problem solution.
- Excellence in public relations, conflict resolution, interpersonal relationship, initiation development and management is a pre-requisite
