Essential Job duties / Scope of Work:

- Administers prescribed medication and treatments in accordance with approved nursing techniques.
- Participate in capacity building and supervision of nurse assistant, CHPs and community related activities.
- Manage patients that seek health care services in the IMC clinics in accordance with the national guidelines, protocols and international recommended standard health care practices.
- Carry out minor surgeries (suture of fresh wound, incision of abscess and dressing) and stabilizes serious sick patients.
- Demonstrate universal infection control practices in the working places.
- Participate in quality improvements activities (Meeting, training etc.)
- Respect client right and confidentiality of their health Information (keep their private and confidentiality of their medical information, provide appropriate information and allow them to express their concerns and make informed choice).



- Respond to life saving situation based upon nursing standards, policies, procedures and protocols.
- Document services provided at the OPDs, verify, Compile and submit the health care services report to M&E unit on weekly bases.
- Perform other additional activities given by the immediate supervisor to strengthen the program.
- Promote good working relationship between the community members, community health committee and the clinical staff at the PHCC/PHCU clinic through respecting individual rights.
- Actively promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within International Medical Corps and amongst beneficiaries served by International Medical Corps.
