III. Position Description:

- · Formation of new cooperatives or businesses, and strengthening of existing ones
- Establishment of coffee processing stations (wet mills) and set-up mobile purchasing points
- Staff and leadership training including direct supervision of a team of harvest assistants
- Creating awareness to cooperative leaders, staff and farmers of the AAA standards for sustainable coffee production.
