Organizational background

IMA World Health is seeking a Community Engagement Officer based in Juba with frequent travel to the field. S/he will review and provide technical input and materials with messages to targeted beneficiaries under the KalaCore program in South Sudan. S/he will assist in training and supervision visits in collaboration with the Kala Azar (KA) field teams, community health workers and the county health departments. This position will report to the Kala Azar Team Leader.

Duties:

- Develop a behavior change communication strategy in consultation with the Department of Health
 Education at the MOH and implement it throughout the life of the project
- Review the BCC approach to determine the quality, uptake of messages and methods of dissemination
- Work closely with the KA team to achieve program objectives and targets effectively and efficiently
- Visit communities to observe dissemination of messages and speak with beneficiaries to identify the effectiveness of campaigns with regards to reach and uptake
- Train health workers and community on health education and BCC
- · Ensure BCC materials and messages are widely disseminated
- Liaise with local radio stations to air BCC messages on Kala Azar and other NTDs
- Conduct monitoring and evaluation of specific BCC activities
- Prepare and submit weekly, monthly and annual data and reports
