Purpose of the position:

The Education Officer will be expected to: oversee the establishment of TLS within the agreed minimum standards; undertake school facility rehabilitation that is inclusive and gender sensitive; enhance children literacy and numeracy abilities; provide capacity support to teachers including training Arabic oriented teachers in English language, strengthen the capacity of the existing school management committees (SMC) and parents' teachers association (PTAs) to support effective and efficient school management; and support pedagogy, life skills and conflict sensitive education and peace education to learners and

Major Roles and Responsibilities of the Education Officer

- 1. Manage planning, implementation, coordination & reporting of project activities (50%)
 - Together with the project manager, plan and manage baseline assessment in the target schools.
 - Ensure that planning and scheduling of planned activity is adequately done at all time, risks to implementation identified, feasible actions identified and the required resources available on time.
 - Ensure that all planned activities are implemented within the required time, cost and quality in all

- Ensure strict adherence to relevant guideline and standards as per World Vision, MoGEI and EiE for all works, services and activity implementation including TLS construction and classroom
- Ensure prompt and effective coordination with relevant stakeholders, partners and communities
- Participate in all education meeting at state, county and school level and adequately represent World Vision at the state education cluster level meetings.
- Support all the target schools in undertaking all the planned reading activities at school and
- Undertake identification and procurement of educational materials, equipment and supplies. Support timely delivery and distribution of all education supplies to the target schools.
- Monitor the implementation of all activities at school and community level, track progress in
- Provide capacity support to assistant education officers in the implementation of project
- Submit quality and timely report as required on bi-weekly and monthly basis including 5W. Ensure documentation of lesson learnt and success stories.
- Perform other duties as required/delegated by the Project Manager.

2. Manage delivery of capacity building of volunteer teachers and other stakeholders (50%)

- Sourcing/developing the training materials for English as a language, school manager's training or liaising with the relevant partners to acquire the required materials and seeking approval before
- Deliver English teacher training courses to Arabic oriented teachers, SMC/PTA trainings in areas of school development planning, resource mobilization, financial management and accountability and ensure that the materials/content delivered meet trainees' needs, learning style and language background for improved teaching and learning at school level.
- Helping learners improve their listening, speaking, reading and writing skills via individual and group sessions in English as a language. Support active participation while applying the practical aspects of key learning points in the schools/communities;
- Continuous assessment of capacity building needs at school level and developing viable actions to
- Oversee the creation and management of children's and youth groups for life skills training and
- Ensure timely submission of training reports and document training outcomes.

- A minimum of a Degree in development related field such as education, psychology and social sciences from a reputable education institution.
- Minimum of 5 years work experience implementing education in emergency activities in South Sudan
- Experience in managing donor funded projects including UNICEF supported projects.
- A good understanding of the South Sudan education system at national and state level
- · Ability to design and deliver capacity building activities to teachers in areas of; material development, subject matter content, English language, literacy and numeracy skill enhancement, etc.
- Experience in Project management and budget management.
- Proficient in English and Arabic languages. Knowledge of the Zande, Shiluk, and Dinka is an advantage.
