Organizational Background

International Medical Corps is a global, humanitarian, nonprofit organization dedicated to saving lives and relieving suffering through health care training and relief and development programs. Its mission is to improve the quality of life through health interventions and related activities that build local capacity in underserved communities worldwide. By offering training and health care to local populations and medical assistance to people at highest risk, and with the flexibility to respond rapidly to emergency situations, International Medical Corps rehabilitates devastated health care systems and helps bring them back to self-reliance.

Essential Job duties / Scope of Work

- Examine, diagnose and treat non complicated cases in Mobile Medical Units according to standard guidelines and protocols available.
- Evaluates and triages complicated cases, referring them to the Medical Doctor/Clinical Officer
- Performs in the hospital minor surgeries (suture of fresh wounds, incision of abscess, and dressing).
- Participates in technical supervision of other nurses and nurses aids in completion of their services and in supervision for safe usage of medical equipment and drugs.
- Follow up of referred cases to higher health facilities and feeding centers, giving feed back to the Medical Doctor/Clinical Officer
- Participates in quality improvement activities (meetings, trainings etc.)
- Ensures high level of infection prevention and contraol measures are in place.
- Training and supervision of CHWs and participate in community related activities.
- Compile daily, weekly mortality and morbidity data and submit to M&E department according to the IMC data management protocol and act upon suspected or confirmed communicable diseases according to standard protocols.

- Any other task given by the supervisor to strengthen the program.
- Actively promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within International Medical Corps and amongst beneficiaries served by International Medical Corps.

- At least 2 years of experience working in similar position
