The overall purpose of this position is to coordinate Hygiene activities and enhance hygiene practices in school supported by the project in Rajaf.

Major Roles and Responsibilities of the School Hygiene Promoter

- Coordinate School mobilization and sensitization of Hygiene activities in the schools in Rajaf County in collaboration with Project team and County Education Department.
- Supervise and mentor girls in Hygiene Promotion activities, ensuring that quality hygiene promotion training, and interventions are conducted as outlined in the project proposal and with set budget.
- Supervise and monitor the construction, use and cleanliness of latrines together with the hygiene promotion clubs in schools.
- Help in the formation and training of hygiene promotion committees on sensitization and mobilization of communities on promotion of sanitation.

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

- Minimum certificate in environmental/Public health, or related to any health background, A diploma will be preferred.

Purpose of the position:

The Assistant project officer will implement, monitor and support performance of World Vision South Sudan Rejaf education project activities. S/he will support and Protection committees in schools and local community perform on-going monitoring and support supervision, program planning, liaising with local government and Non-Governmental Organization partners, and staff capacity building.

Major Roles and Responsibilities of the Assistant Education Officer

- Ensure that the Protection components in the education project are implemented according to national guidelines, and program objectives; Prepare and manage a work plan to ensure that all projects activities are well supported
- Coordinate with GIK for acquisition of Protection supplies by identifying and compiling needs, support preparation of distribution plans and preparation of post distribution reports.
- Follow up with field staff to ensure that weekly and monthly updates are submitted timely to the education project manager
- · Identify staff capacity gaps, train and mentors staff for better performance in protection
- Participate in rapid assessments to provide an overview of the situation on the ground in order to estimate the immediate needs of the population within the area of operations and select the most appropriate intervention strategy

- Conduct regular support visits to protection committees to ensure quality of performance and
- Prepare and timely submit Child protection incidence reports to responsible persons as per the
- Maintain effective working relationships with local authorities, World Vision Protection team, other NGOs, and community-based organizations.
- Prepare internal reports within agreed deadlines using WVSS and donor formats, as required; including the cluster weekly updates and monthly reports.

- Bachelor's Degree in Education, Psychology, Social Work with at least 1 year working experience in Protection/Education or Diploma in the same discipline with at least 3 years hands on experience in emergency Protection programming.
