SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

The Samaritan's Purse (SP) WASH Program is currently carrying out humanitarian relief activities to reduce the incidence of water borne and hygiene related diseases among the most vulnerable populations in Mayendit County. SP is now beginning manual drilling of boreholes in Mayendit County. The Drilling Coordinator's main responsibilities will be planning, organizing, and managing resources of drilling operations, water quality testing, pump installation, and borehole siting. The Coordinator will also be responsible for coordinating and leading community mobilization in line with the drilling activities and submitting regular reports.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Lead and participate in field assessments and surveys for productive borehole siting.
- Prepare purchase plan for procuring drilling supplies and consumables on time.
- Coordinate overall drilling operations, water quality testing, well head construction and pump installation.
- Ensure the borehole drilled is in compliance with community needs, donor's requirement, and SP and national standards.
- Conduct on-site drilling supervision and provide technical assistance to the drilling crew.
- Prepare well log, casing arrangements, and well completion reports together with the GPS locations.
- Assume other duties assigned by WASH PM.
- Maintain a Christian witness to the communities.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

- College diploma or university degree required, preferably in Geology, Hydrogeology, Hydraulic Engineering, or a related field
- Two years of experience working in drillings, preferably manual drilling technologies
- Experience working for an INGO preferred
