## VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

### COUNTRY PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The overall objective of the ARC South Sudan program is to assist the South Sudanese to respond and react to community needs. To achieve this objective, ARC implements a multi-sectoral program that includes primary health care, tertiary care, Nutrition, WASH and Gender based violence prevention and response activities. ARC currently works closely with the County Health Departments in large scale county wide health and nutrition programming. ARCs GBV programming is expanding its outreach mechanisms and introducing innovative new initiatives. ARC has program activities in Central and Eastern Equatoria, Northern Bahr Gazal, and Upper Nile.

### PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

Based in Liwolo Kajo-Keji, the WASH Supervisor will provide technical support in implementation of ARC's water, sanitation and hygiene promotion projects in Kajokeji / Liwolo of South Sudan. S/he will assist in design WASH infrastructure that is appropriate for each stage of the emergency and recovery ensuring the continued effectiveness of the WASH programme as the situation evolves.

### MAJOR AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY PRIMARY DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist WASH Coordinator in Start-up, implement, and monitor WASH project activities appropriate to specific sectors of the community
- Participate in assessments of the condition of water and sanitation infrastructure, solid waste management practices, condition of drainage, and overall hygiene awareness;
- Assist WASH Coordinator to design activities that will address the potential sources of disease; contain or eliminate these sources and prevent further transmission and outbreaks, all in accordance with the assessment findings, in coordination with the other actors and stakeholders



- Assist and / or partnering WASH Coordinator to manage NFI distributions and infrastructure repairs
- Sensitize communities on key hygiene practices (gender sensitive) with whom to engage and define an appropriate communications strategy to promote safe practices.
- Partnering WASH Coordinator in identification of appropriate maintenance mechanisms and sustainability of the rehabilitated latrines, water points and household infrastructures.
- Partnering WASH Coordinator to ensure technical and programmatic quality of ARC WASH projects in Kajojeji / Liwolo
- Assist WASH Coordinator to manage a plan to monitor activities, outputs and impact.
- Provide regular and reliable updates on the implementation progress, challenges, reflecting lessons learned
- Work together with other WASH team members to ensure that the various aspects of the WASH response are integrated, and that they form part of a coherent public health response.
- Supervise WASH team / community workers as needed and directed by WASH Coordinator
- Ensure all activities are carried out in accordance with local government procedures (e.g. site selection) and do not duplicate or interfere with activities proposed or carried out by the UN or other NGOs
- Liaise with other organisations /entities engaged in similar activities in South Sudan
- Liaise closely with relevant ARC staff and community workers
- Contribute to the development of indicators and M&E tools as well as qualitative and quantitative surveys
- Any other task as directed by WASH Coordinator / Program Manager

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## EDUCATION, TECHNICAL SKILLS & KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED

- Relevant education / degree in Public Health Engineering (Water & Sanitation) or similar discipline
- Minimum 3 years' experience in implementation of WASH projects in conflict and post-conflict rural settings in South Sudan; Preferably at community level ( IDP / Refugee camp , Host communities)
- Knowledge and experience of working with rural communities & local government authorities in a remote post conflict setting
- Understanding of the principles behind and experience in the implementation of WASH programmes and CLTS is a plus.

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## KEY BEHAVIORS & ABILITIES

- Strong implementation skills with a willingness to follow relevant policies and procedures
- Compute Skills ; MS Office; Excel
- Good communication skills, including ability to present issues
- Experience in capacity building and training of staff, community workers and target groups, especially in community mobilization, hygiene promotion and CLTS



- Political and cultural awareness and sensitivity
  - Ability to understand and integrate gender issues within a conservative environment and a post conflict setting
  - Fluency in written and spoken English is essential; knowledge in local languages is a must
  - Ability to work well under pressure and in response to changing needs
