Under the overall leadership of the Area Coordinator.

Job Summary The primary function of this position is Management of the Transit Centre/First Level registration centre. The Position is responsible for New arrivals/Asylum seekers reception, Welfare, Safety, Accommodation, Feeding, Social and Health needs, Protection, Relocation and management of the Transit centre staff.

Summary of Duties & Responsibilities

- Manage the Transit centre and direct the daily activities of the transit centre
- Manage, supervise and assign the transit centre staff daily activities
- Receive and record the number of new arrivals
- Provide the feeding and accommodation for the new arrivals
- Take care of the social, protection and Health need to the new arrivals in collaboration with other agencies/partners
- Ensure adequate sanitation, cleanliness and conducive environment within the transit centre
- Ensure adequate safety and security of the new arrivals within the transit centre
- In collaboration with the UNHCR Protection and registration team and CRA assist in the registration of the new arrivals
- Organise of the relocation of the new arrivals and supervise the convoy movements and safety
- Keep records of the new arrivals received, accommodated and relocated
- Identify and assist or refer to the relevant agencies the new arrivals with special need

- Provide adequate social, Health and sanitation orientation for the new arrivals
- Organise the new arrivals in groups and leadership for them to participate in the provision of their services and other welfare
- Participate in the relocation of the Old refugee case load from Yida to Jamjang camps

Person specifications

- At least a diploma in Social Studies or any relevant field from a reputable institution
- At least 2 year working experience in related field

Skills and Competencies

- INGO experience is highly desirable, knowledge of local culture & language preferred though not mandatory
- A good command of both English and basic Arabic languages is a requirement
- Good knowledge and understanding of refugee protection
- Innovative and ability to learn on job
- Ability to work under hardship with limited resource and minimal supervision
- Flexibility and team work is necessary
- Candidate should be self-motivated
- Computer literate, able to use database software and Ms Office packages.
